## Attention All Players ...

After 13 years, Mingara's annual **Double Trouble** snooker tournament (handicap doubles) now has a new position on the calendar – moving from end November to early in the New Year.

The 14<sup>th</sup> staging of this successful event will now be held on 28<sup>th</sup> – 29<sup>th</sup> January 2017.

Mingara's **Double Trouble** tournaments will now be played as part of the established annual Tournaments conducted by the Greater Western Snooker Circuit (GWSC).

The GWSC group, based in NSW's Central Western Districts, have conducted successful doubles snooker tournaments for many years now at various clubs in Lithgow, Bathurst, Cowra, Dubbo, Mudgee, etc. In recent years their popular monthly circuit has expanded to also include clubs in the Illawarra and Nowra areas.

All players would be aware that our sport has been severely impacted by the decision of many registered clubs to remove billiard tables from their premises. Unfortunately, this is a trend being faced by players throughout NSW and the GWSC circuit has also been adversely affected, with loss of club tables over the years resulting in several GWSC events being forced to find alternate hosting venues – if at all possible. This situation is the reason behind GWSC's approach to Mingara.

Mingara Snooker & Billiards Club's committee understood the importance of maintaining the GWSC concept and that its continued viability and success was much greater than just our own tournament. In a show of support and solidarity for our sport, we've had no hesitation in affiliating with GWSC as a host venue and are proud to bring our future **Pouble Trouble** tournaments under their banner.

Our committee trusts that players will understand this decision and the subsequent change in programing in order to accommodate both the GWSC and Mingara annual calendars.

<u>PLEASE NOTE:</u> Mingara (and the GWSC) are now looking for the support of all players to ensure this special joint venture tournament will be a success.

Men, women and juniors are all welcome. No membership/affiliation fees required. Great facilities. Come and play at the home of the Australian Masters Snooker Championship – April 2017 will mark the 10<sup>th</sup> consecutive year for Mingara as host venue.
